PRESIDENT'S GOLF & GALA

February 2-3, 2024

FORMAT: Each team consists of 2 men and 2 women.

Friday round is a Shamble - scoring 2 net best balls - on the Challenge Course with a shotgun beginning at noon. On each hole, after all players have hit their tee shot, the team selects the best drive and then everyone plays his/her own ball from that point for the remainder of the hole. A minimum of 2 drives is required for each player and a maximum of 6 per player. Handicap (because of the Shamble format) will be 50% of each player's handicap in order to determine low net scores on each hole.

Saturday round is a traditional four person team Scramble on the Championship Course beginning at 8:00 am. Team handicaps will be determined by 20% of lowest handicap + 15% of 2nd lowest handicap + 10% of third lowest handicap + 5% of highest handicap. A minimum of 2 drives is required for each player and there will be a maximum of 6 drives per player. The team score will be its gross score - Handicap = Net Score.

Turn in scorecards both days upstairs.

ENTRY FEE: \$110 per player.

ENTRY DATES: Entries open January 11th, 2024, then close January 28, 2024 at 5:00 pm

(cancellations no later than January 30, 2024 at 5:00 pm).

FLIGHTS: Based on team handicaps and determined by the pro shop.

TEES: Men play from the White or Silver tees. Women play from the gold tees.

RULES: All 2021 USGA rules are in effect as well as the local rules printed on the

scorecard. If there are any controversies with respect to any rule, play a second

ball and consult with the pro shop after your round.

Hole out all putts.

Pick the best ball but conditions must remain the same ie if in rough, must stay in

the rough.

POSTING: Do not post either round because of the formats.

F&B: Brunch on Friday and breakfast on Saturday - menus and locations to be

announced. The annual Presidents' Ball and dinner will be held Saturday night. No host cocktails will be available in the lounge followed by dinner on Saturday. There will be a program to honor all Presidents, past and present, of mens and ladies golf clubs. Sport coats are required for gentlemen & cocktail

attire for women. Dancing will follow dinner.
